UVU SPRING COURSES BEGIN MONDAY, January 7, 2019

**Students need to be admitted to UVU and enrolled in LI college courses
 BEFORE the first day of UVU Spring classes**

Admission to UVU will cost a one-time \$35 non-refundable fee paid to the university through the high school Concurrent Enrollment program. Log on to www.uvu.edu/concurrent to get started by following 1. Admission, Get admitted to UVU (If you currently participate in UVU concurrent enrollment or have done so in the past this step has been done. Skip to 2. Registration, Enroll in your courses)

After completing UVU admission students are assigned a UVU ID number. This number is used to log in to their student account portal MyUVU for course registration. CRN's (course registration numbers) are provided by Mrs. Pulver in the Concurrent Enrollment/Distance Learning room located in the Media Center. Students participating in a DL course buy their own textbooks etc. and pay low tuition of \$5 per credit hour payable to UVU. There is also \$10 class fee paid to THS Financial Office for participation in this program.



High School Junior and Senior Students can take actual UVU courses through Concurrent Enrollment via Live Interactive Education!

Live Interactive Education (formally called Distance Learning) is another great opportunity for Timpview students to earn college credit while in high school. Utah Valley Professors are on the UVU campus teaching in a classroom designed to transmit the class throughout the state. The high-tech equipment enables students to communicate with the professor on campus in real-class time while attending their class at Timpview High School in the Media Center.

Why take Live Interactive Classes?

- Earn high school and college credit at the same time
- Convenient: classes are attended right on the high school campus
- Reduced Tuition of only \$5 per credit hour (student responsible for text books, ebooks, clickers etc. if needed for their class)
- Classes are taught by UVU instructors in semester-based classes (earning 1.0 high school credit per semester)
- Classes fulfill college General Education requirements
- Get a jumpstart on college!

Who should take Live Interactive (LI) Classes?

- Junior and Senior students with 3.0 GPA or higher and meet ACT requirements for college English, Math and Biology courses
- Students wanting a challenge through rigor
- Self- motivated and disciplined students who understand the importance of attendance and good study skills
- Confident students that like expressing themselves through written communication
- Students ready to move on to college!

How do I participate in LI Courses?

- Meet with Lisa Pulver, the CE coordinator, in the Media Center at Timpview for details, courses offerings, and enrollment instructions BEFORE each semester begins
- Report or submit ACT scores or AP (Advanced Placement) scores to UVU
- Obtain and complete a LI Qualification Form from Lisa Pulver (This requires admission to UVU)
- Meet with your high school counselor

Participation requires students to block out odd/even high school class time. UVU courses follow the UVU schedule and calendar. UVU courses may begin before high school classes begin in the fall (August) or before the end of first semester in January.

Note: Students passing the AP English Composition exam with a score of 3, 4, or 5 MUST have scores submitted to UVU directly through the College Board PRIOR to registration in ENG 2010 or PHIL 205G. Students may also enroll in these courses by passing ENG 1010 with a C grade or better.
